Green Revolution focused on “modern varieties” supported by irrigation and agro-chemicals for increased production. However, this input intensification became regressive affecting soil, water, air, biodiversity and health, gradually also bringing in yield stagnation.

SYSTEM OF CROP OR ROOT INTENSIFICATION (SCI / SRI) on the other hand achieves **HIGHER** production with **LESSER** inputs like water, seed, land, labour and capital through simple changes in crop management practices. SCI practices help farmers to unlock the latent potential that is inherent in a crop and soil biota.

Chetna Organic Farmers Association, along with ASHA, PRAN, Living Farms and WASSAN invites interested farmers, practitioners and NGO workers for a 2-day Skillshare on SCI/SRI, focusing on Kharif season crops like Pigeonpea, Millets and Paddy. This is an opportunity to learn from expert practitioners, including farmers who have achieved success with SCI / SRI using organic inputs and native seeds. ***Travel costs and course fees have to be borne by interested trainees.***
